Assemblyman Carroll Finding Solutions to Community Issues

My team and I are here to serve and we help constituents solve issues every day. From helping individuals file unemployment claims and assisting homeowners with applying for STAR tax credits or utility rebates, to making sure the State is filling pot holes on our state roads and many other matters, my team has helped resolve hundreds of constituent cases already this year. If you have an issue, no matter how big or small, please contact my office and we will do whatever we can to assist you.

Assemblyman Carroll Shares Important Resources

With costs continuing to rise due to inflation, tariffs, and corporate greed, too many families are struggling with paying their bills and the increased cost of living. Here are some resources through New York State that you and your family may be eligible for.

STAR (School Tax Relief) Credit: An annual tax credit for households earning under \$500,000. To be eligible, you must be the homeowner and use the property as your primary residence. You can check your eligibility and enroll through the NYS Department of Taxation and Finance.

Enhanced STAR Credit: Similar to the STAR credit but eligibility is limited to resident property owners aged 65 and above with an income under \$113,550.

POWER Rebate Checks: A one-time energy rebate check to help offset high utility bills. You may be eligible for up to a \$200 rebate if you're a single filer making under \$150,000 or joint filer making under \$300,000.

Solar Energy System Equipment Credit: A credit for homeowners who have purchased or leased solar energy equipment to produce energy on your primary residence. The credit is equal to 25% of your qualified solar energy system equipment expenditures and is limited to \$5,000.

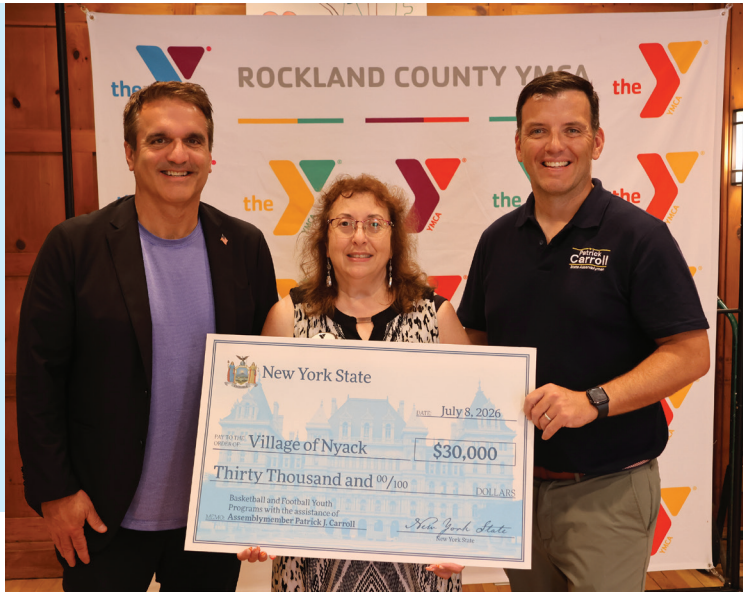

The campers go on weekly trips, swim at Bowline Point Park pool, and enjoy other recreational activities. Assemblyman Carroll presented a \$60,000 check to Mayor Rob D'Amelio and the Village Board to assist with the costs of running the summer camp.

THE NYACK CENTER is a community cornerstone providing affordable before and after school programs for local families. Over 150 children come through the Nyack Center's doors every day. Assemblyman Carroll proudly secured \$30,000 in funding to support their incredible child care programs. JAWONIO INC. OPERATES THE BRICK-IT-AGAIN LEGO STORE IN VALLEY COTTAGE, a unique retail store that serves as a vocational training hub where individuals with disabilities, mental health needs, and chronic conditions gain real-world job experience and social-emotional skills. Assemblyman Carroll recently stopped by the store to present Jawonio with a check for \$130,000 to support the store's operations.

FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS



THE VILLAGE OF NYACK provides recreational programs for local youth in conjunction with the Rockland YMCA. These opportunities range from basketball and kickball programs to soccer and swimming classes. Assemblyman Carroll recently visited the Village to present a check for \$30,000 to support these incredible programs and see many of the activities in action.



THE ARC ROCKLAND provides vital support and services to people with intellectual and developmental disabilities through early childhood education, day habitation programs, residential services, self-advocacy, and more. Assemblyman Carroll recently visited some of their facilities and proudly presented a check of \$40,000 to assist with funding their self-advocacy programs.



MEALS ON WHEELS ROCKLAND delivers over 1,300 meals across the county each day to older adults and home-bound individuals. Hundreds of volunteers and staff make this life-sustaining operation possible. Assemblyman Carroll recently presented a check of \$50,000 to assist with funding for equipment and daily operations.
