JOINING FORCES:

With victims' families to ensure individuals who commit sexual acts (like molestation) and then murder a child under the age of 18 will NEVER be released from prison (A.4661).

PUSHING BACK:

On the cashless bail laws by fighting for more judicial discretion to help keep offenders who pose a public safety risk off our streets (A.5992).
