- ✦ Increase the penalty for making a threat against a police officer (A.4662).
- ✦ Ensure law enforcement officers', firefighters', correction officers' and probation officers' personal records are kept confidential (A.4589).
- ✦ Create the crime of doxing and/or inciting violence against a police officer as a class D felony (A.4595) (A.1530).
- ✦ Establish a state-funded program to help owners cover the cost of veterinary care for their retired K-9s (A.4975).
- ✦ Crack down on false reports of incidents to draw a large number of police officers to a particular location (A.2977).

I understand the important role first responders take on each day to keep our communities safe. To help preserve public safety and show my support for our brave men and women in uniform, I proposed and support policies that would:



- ✦ Offer students loan forgiveness if they meet certain requirements and want to serve their community as a volunteer firefighter (A.5157).
- ✦ Establish a retirement service for fire and/or emergency service volunteers (A.5450A).
- ✦ Issue "Survivor of the Bravest" license plates to family members of a volunteer or paid firefighter who died in the line of duty (A.6411).



- ✦ Support the protection of first responders if they are intentionally exposed to fentanyl or opiates containing fentanyl by making it a first-degree, class B felony (A.4085-A).
- ✦ Provide a tax exemption for members of volunteer fire companies and/or voluntary ambulance services in Rockland County (A.4666).
