**\$150,000 for Piermont Public Safety
and Drainage Improvements**



Following a meeting with Piermont Mayor Nathan Mitchell and Trustee Jeff Gordon, Assemblyman Wieder secured \$150,000 in state funding for key public safety and infrastructure improvements. The funding will provide upgraded emergency communication equipment for the police and fire departments and support drainage improvements along Ritie Street.
