## Scott is taking bi-partisan action to:

- **Enact** the “Rebuild Our Schools Act” to increase aid for exclusive school districts.<sup>1</sup>
- **Extend** and protect freedom of speech and the press in school-sponsored newspapers.<sup>2</sup>
- **Provide** four Comprehensive Autism Assessment Centers designed to ensure children with Autism Spectrum Disorders receive a comprehensive assessment leading to more effective interventions.<sup>3</sup>
- **Strengthen** reporting of suspected in-school child abuse and include parental notification.<sup>4</sup>
- **Implement** a comprehensive civic education curriculum in all public and charter schools for grades five through twelve.<sup>5</sup>
- **Include** certain veterans as eligible in-state residents for community and public four-year colleges.<sup>6</sup>
