Assemblymember Phil Steck secures funding for *Schenectady County* communities

Town of Niskayuna projects

2021

- \$250,000 for improvements to the athletic fields at Jeff Blatnick Park

2018

- \$125,000 for renovations and paving at the Niskayuna Fire District No. 1 station on River Road
- \$250,000 for renovations and upgrades at River Road Park



2017

- \$125,000 multi-modal grant for drainage improvements and paving within the Upper Union Street neighborhood
- \$25,000 to purchase an electric car for the town Building Department

2016

- \$250,000 to repave the bike path and create connecting sidewalks across the town
- \$125,000 to purchase new fuel pumps for the town garage fuel dispensing system

2014

- \$125,000 for streetscape enhancements along Upper Union Street

City of Schenectady projects

2019

- \$125,000 to establish the Woodlawn Preserve Trail System with signage and replant trees and other vegetation along the trail
- \$125,000 for energy-efficient LED lighting at Schenectady City Hall, saving taxpayer dollars
- \$125,000 to erect a statue of Dr. Elizabeth Gillette, a suffragist who was elected to the state Assembly in 1919, a year before women obtained the right to vote, as well as perform landscaping and masonry work

2018

- \$125,000 for a new storage shed at the Central Park Greenhouse Facility

2017

- \$250,000 multi-modal grant for crosswalk improvements on Van Vranken Avenue
- \$25,000 for playground equipment at Steinmetz Park

2016

- \$250,000 for improvements to the Emergency Service Training Center, including rebuilding the training tower and repaving the facility



2015

- \$1 million grant for improvements to the Central Park "A" Diamond and the Music Haven amphitheater and tennis courts

2014

- \$500,000 for improvements to Central Park, including new artificial turf at Buck Ewing Fields, enhancements at Music Haven and landscaping and terracing
