Steck passed legislation to:

- ☑ Ensure funds received from legal settlements brought against corporate opioid manufacturers and distributors are strictly used for abuse prevention, treatment and recovery programs, as well as public education campaigns (Ch. 190 of 2021)
- ✓ Create the position of state Chief Disability Officer to make New York a model of inclusivity, integration and accessibility for individuals with disabilities (Ch. 834 of 2021)
- ☑ Remove the state tax that funeral homes have been unnecessarily required to pay for each burial, which ultimately gets passed along to grieving families (A.9231)



- ✓ Establish statewide uniformity regarding objections to candidate nominating petitions, thus providing due process for all candidates for public office (A.4261)
- ✓ Develop the statewide New York Matters program to assist our first responders in quickly and compassionately helping those with substance abuse and mental health disorders and placing them into treatment (2022–23 State Budget)
