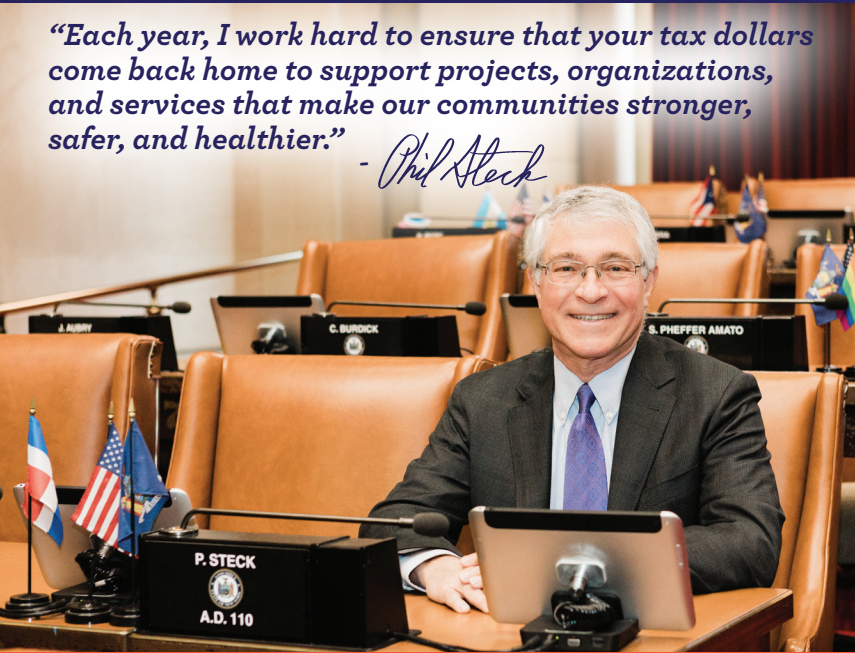

In the 2025-26 state budget, Assemblymember Steck secured more than \$2 million for local priorities across the 110th Assembly District, including:
