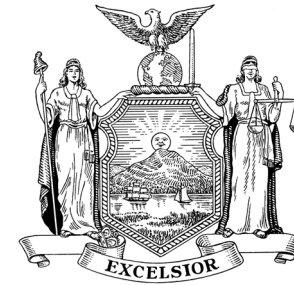




# The Assembly State of New York

*Whereas, in 1956, Lucy and Joseph were wed, beginning their new chapter together in Rotterdam and having their son, Christopher, in 1960, and would go on to enjoy 64 years of marriage; and*

*Whereas, Lucy worked for 35 years as the administrative assistant to the principal of Schalmont Central schools, playing a key role in keeping our education system running smoothly until her retirement in 1985; and*

*Whereas, Lucy remains active and high-spirited, living in Guilderland and remaining a staple in the lives of her family, including her son, two grandsons and two great-grandchildren; and*
