working to ensure our families have clean water

In this year's state budget,  
Assemblyman Santabarbara helped secure:

- ✓ **\$500 million** for Clean Water Infrastructure
- ✓ **\$400 million** for the Environmental Protection Fund, including:



- **\$22.25 million** for water quality improvement projects
- **\$14.3 million** for waterfront revitalization projects

Assemblyman Santabarbara: A civil engineer

- ✓ Co-sponsored and passed the **Lead Pipe Right to Know Act** to inform the public about how to protect yourself from the risks posed by lead pipes<sup>1</sup>
- ✓ Helped establish the **Clean Water Infrastructure Act** that funds clean water initiatives, including funding to help replace lead water service lines<sup>2</sup>



New York recently secured **\$129 million** in federal funding for the state's Lead Service Line Replacement Program. This crucial funding will help communities across the state, including ours, replace dangerous and outdated lead service lines that supply water to our homes.
