Taking Action to Protect Our Amsterdam Community

Enacted 2024-25 state budget safety measures

- ✓ CRACKING DOWN ON ILLEGAL CANNABIS by empowering enforcement agencies to take stronger steps against the unscrupulous, unregulated cannabis dispensaries that pose a threat to the health and safety of our neighborhoods.
- ✓ CRACKING DOWN ON RETAIL THEFT by strengthening penalties for repeat offenses, assaults on retail workers and selling stolen merchandise. Assemblyman Santabarbara also helped make funding available to help businesses make security improvements.
- ✓ CLARIFYING SQUATTER LANGUAGE IN STATE LAW by explicitly defining a "squatter" as someone with whom no landlord-tenant relationship exists, helping protect the rights of landlords and tenants alike.

New measures to enhance public safety

- ✓ Legislation to strengthen penalties for manslaughter resulting in the death of a child, elevating these crimes to a Class A-1 felony (A.10066).
- ✓ Legislation that would establish new standards for the safety and security of school grounds to ensure our children and educators are protected (A.3728).



Passed legislation to keep our children safe online

- ✓ STOP ADDICTIVE FEEDS EXPLOITATION (SAFE) FOR KIDS ACT bans social media from showing addictive content to minors without parental consent and restricts late-night notifications (Chap. 120 of 2024).
- ✓ NEW YORK CHILD DATA PROTECTION ACT safeguards minors' online privacy by limiting the collection of their personal data without explicit consent. (Chap. 121 of 2024).
