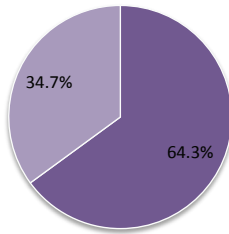

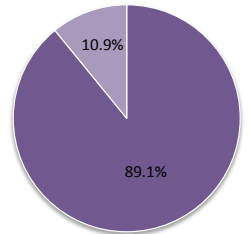

35.7% Support



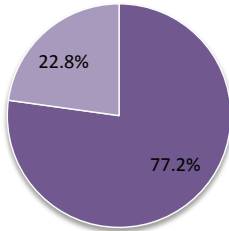
Should taxpayers fund an increase in the minimum wage for inmates in state prisons?

10.9% Support



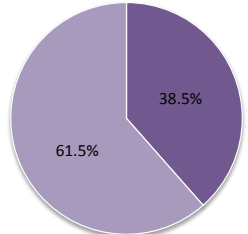
Do you support a move to "single-payer health care" in New York, a system by which the state would take over all health coverage and provide insurance to all New Yorkers?

22.8% Support



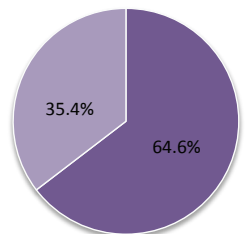
Do you think the state should provide funding to allow for a School Resource Officer in every school in New York State?

61.5% Support



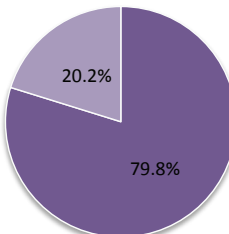

35.4% Good for NY



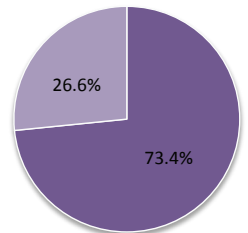
If it meant your taxes would increase, would you support a move to "single-payer health care" in New York?

20.2% Support



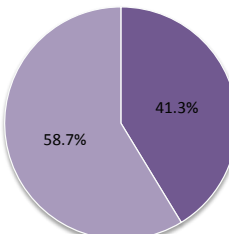
Would you support raising the age for purchasing tobacco to 21 years old statewide?

26.6% Oppose



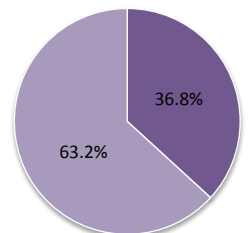
Do you support the ban of plastic bags in supermarkets and grocery stores?

58.7% Support



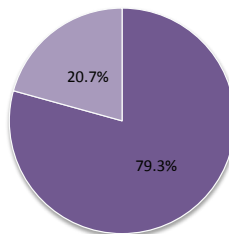
Do you support the Medical Aid in Dying Act, which allows physicians to prescribe a lethal dose of medication to a terminally ill patient upon request?

63.2% Support



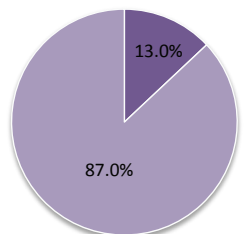

20.7% Support



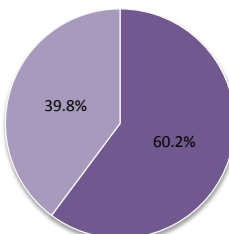
Do you support or oppose giving driver's licenses to undocumented immigrants?

87% Oppose



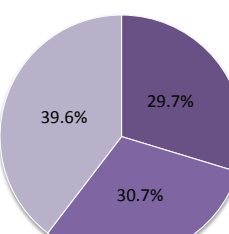

We participated in another Operation Safe Stop press conference hosted by the New York Association of Pupil Transportation (NYAPT) Capital Region Chapter. This session we passed legislation allowing municipalities around the state to implement the usage of school bus safety cameras, which will help enforce penalties for people who dangerously pass buses that are stopped.
