In today's world, child care is not a simple choice. It's not even a luxury. For many working families today, child care is essential. That's why I've partnered on many initiatives to help give families options and support as they work and care for their children.



I SUPPORT THE ABC PLAN THAT WOULD:

- Increase the Empire State Child Credit amount to 45% of the federal Child Tax Credit amount (A.2492)
- Create a new Child Care Facility Capital Improvement Tax Credit to help child care providers enhance and update facilities (A.2392)
- Double the existing Child Care Creation & Expansion Tax Credit amount from \$25 million per year to \$50 million per year (A.2393)
- Allow local municipalities to offer a partial property tax exemption for licensed child daycare centers to encourage development (A.2002)

I ALSO VOTED YES ON THE BUDGET TO:

- Expand scholarship support for students earning a master's degree in early childhood education to help strengthen the workforce that cares for and teaches our youngest children (A.10006-C)
- Keep the current funding structure in place for residential placements outside New York City, giving families and schools more stability for another year (A.10006-C)
