

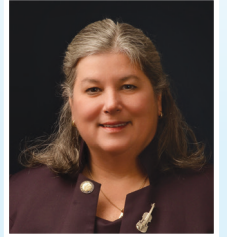

## Assemblywoman Carrie Woerner: SUPPORTING OUR EMS AGENCIES

- Allow air transport ambulances to carry blood and emergency medical technicians on board to **perform transfusions** (A.2561-B)
- **Allow claims for death or disability benefits** due to vascular rupture, which was inspired by the tragic death of Whitehall Volunteer Fire Company Chief James Brooks (A.6767-A)
- **Regulate the use of flame-retardant chemicals** in upholstered furniture, mattresses and electronics to reduce the impact of fires (A.5418-B)

*Assemblywoman Woerner introduced and is continuing to advocate for a bill that would increase the tax credit for volunteer firefighters and EMS members from \$200 to \$1,200 (A.886).*

*Assemblywoman Woerner also helped pass legislation that designates emergency responders, dispatchers and operators as “**first responders in communications**” and provides benefits for people who were employed in qualified service during the World Trade Center rescue, recovery and cleanup operations.*
