Local victories

- **\$12.5 million** for the Village of Tupper Lake to upgrade their water system*
- **\$1 million** to the Adirondack Watershed Institute*
- **\$300,000** for the Northern New York State Agriculture Development Program*
- **\$100,000** for the AuSable Valley Central School District*
- **\$50,000** for the Child Care Coordinating Council of the North Country
- **\$50,000** for the North Country Honor Flight
- Passed the **Death Gamble Protections** for Corrections Officers*



Session Wins:

- Enacted a **5-year pause on the electric school bus mandate***
- Passed a **1-year ban on the construction of new data centers** (A.11560)
- Passed the **Protecting Our Wallets Energy Rebate checks**, providing some relief to utility consumers*
- Supported **increasing the personal income tax credit** for volunteer firefighters and ambulance workers (A.6790)
