I AM PROUD TO SPONSOR PRO SECOND AMENDMENT LEGISLATION WHICH:

- Repeals excessive licensing requirements enacted in the 2022 “Concealed Carry Improvement Act”(A.5049)
- Repeals background check fees for gun and ammunition purchases (A.8185)
- Establishes a sales tax exemption for background check fees (A.9872)
- Reduces the hassle for licensed wildlife hunters and pistol permit holders to purchase ammunition without contacting the statewide license and record database (A.8085)
- Permits judges or magistrates to defend themselves and others in the courtroom if danger arises (A.7968-A)
