

## PROPOSALS I SUPPORTED THAT SUCCESSFULLY PASSED IN THE NEW YORK STATE ASSEMBLY AND SENATE THIS YEAR:

- The "Alexander John Smullen Traffic Safety Memorial Law" (A.3938-B/ S.5568-B) will establish a traffic safety sign program to publicly memorialize the victims of fatal vehicle collisions.
- Assembly Bill A.7011-A will increase the donor pool for New Yorkers in need of eye, tissue and/or organ transplants by allowing individuals to register with the New York State Donate Life Registry when they file their income taxes.
- Assembly Bill A.8330-A will help make hunting more accessible for New Yorkers by expanding the use of crossbows during the regular hunting season.

## PROPOSALS I OPPOSED THAT WERE SUCCESSFULLY BLOCKED THIS YEAR:

- ► Assembly Bill A.4881 would have allowed the governor to delay special elections statewide.
- ► The Packaging Reduction and Recycling Infrastructure Act (A.1749) **could have potentially cost New York families \$456 to \$732** annually.

## **NEXT YEAR, I WILL CONTINUE TO:**

**Fight to lower taxes** and lessen regulations imposed on local businesses and families;

Increase support services for first responders, law enforcement, veterans and active service military personnel;

**Improve public safety** and New York's crippled criminal justice system; and

Promote the New York State Donate Life Registry statewide and help increase the number of eligible organ/eye/tissue donors available to save lives.
