

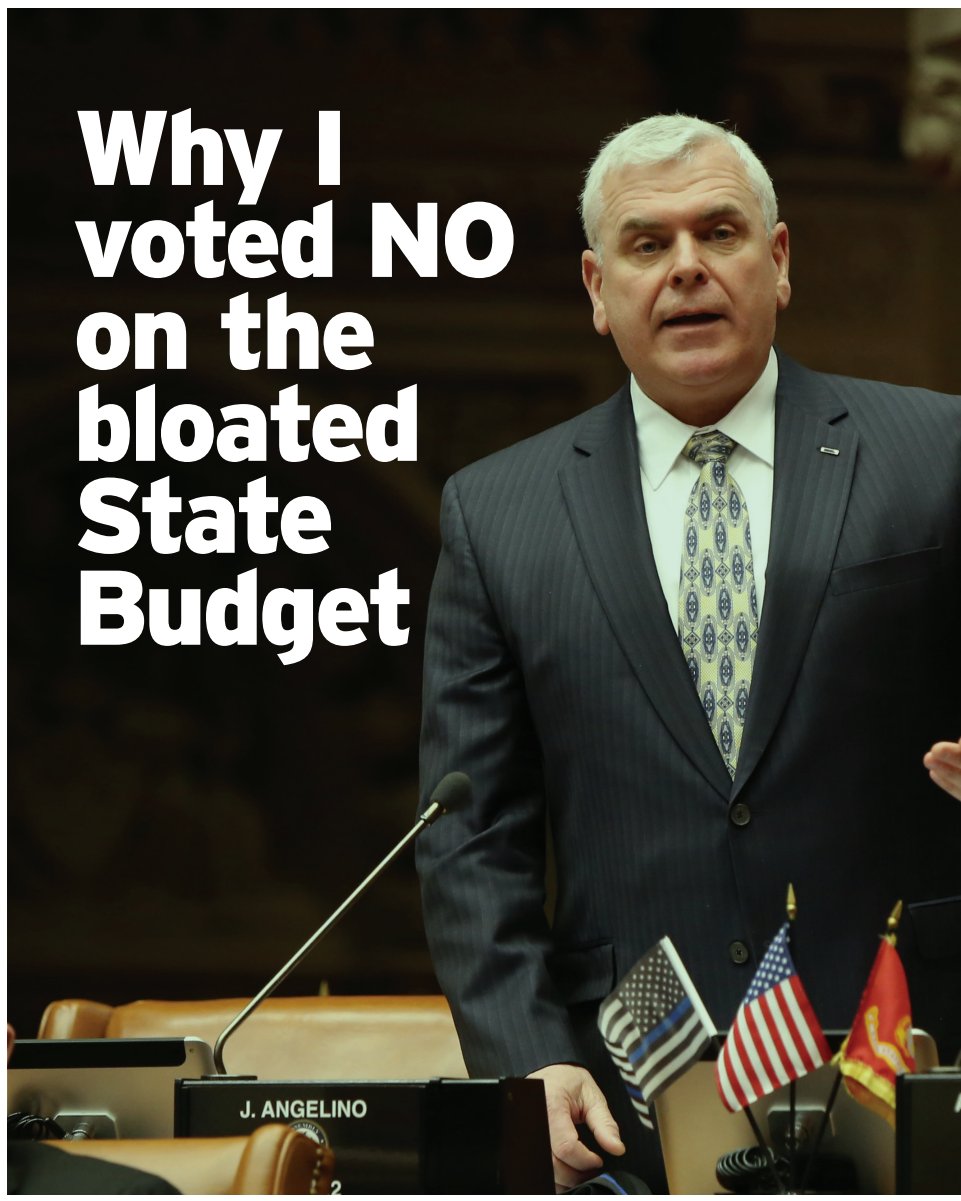
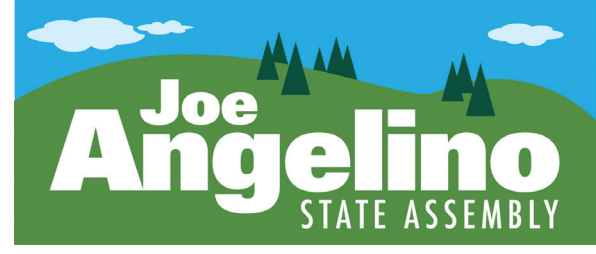

Why I voted NO on the bloated State Budget

JOE ANGELINO: STANDING UP FOR FISCAL SANITY IN NEW YORK.

Like all budgets, the state budget the Legislature passed contained both good and bad. Unfortunately, I had to vote *no* due to the bad greatly outweighing any good included within.

The BAD included:

- *More than \$2 billion to migrants* in New York City (A.8803-D)
- *No meaningful change* to bail reform
- *No reduction in taxes* for the middle class
- *Prison closures* with only a 90-day notice (A.8805-C)
- *Removal of local control* for the siting and routing of transmission lines that will reroute electricity from upstate to New York City (A.8808-C)
- *No increase in funding* to upkeep and improve our local roads and bridges (A.8804-D)
- *No repeal* of tax credits for Hollywood elites
