

***In an effort to help those with small businesses,
Brian has supported legislation to:***

- Allow insurance corporations to receive a tax credit for investing in rural business growth funds to help create jobs and promote economic growth in rural communities (A.2552);
- Create the College to Work program, which would create a tax credit for businesses that develop such a program and pay for the tuition of individuals in exchange for future employment. This would help ensure that more college graduates find jobs in their fields after graduation (A.5345);
- Direct the Department of Economic Development to study the attrition of small retail businesses from the state and create a pilot program to help maintain existing small businesses, as well as train and counsel small business owners and potential small business owners. These steps would help ensure the future of small businesses in New York (A.5349);
- Review and eliminate burdensome regulations and permit requirements on small businesses to help support rather than encumber small businesses (A.4717);
- Enact the Small Business Full Employment Act to help create jobs and provide goods and services to communities (A.4553, 2020); and
- Create the New York Business Emergency Relief Act of 2021 to help employers get back on their feet and help our economy recover (A.4692).
