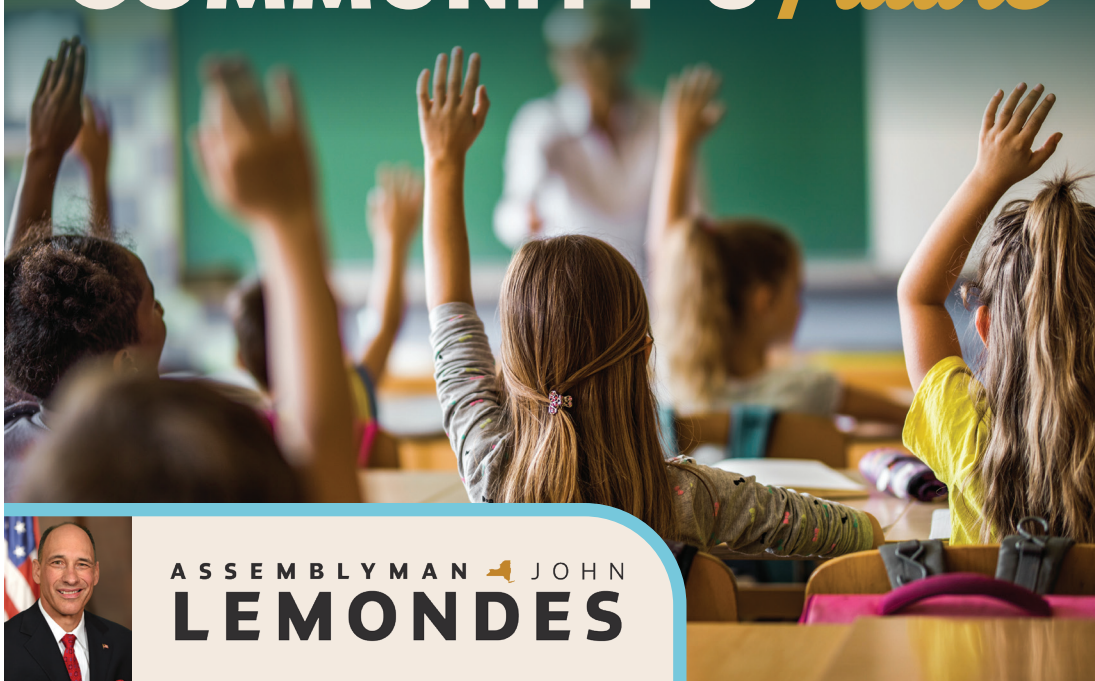


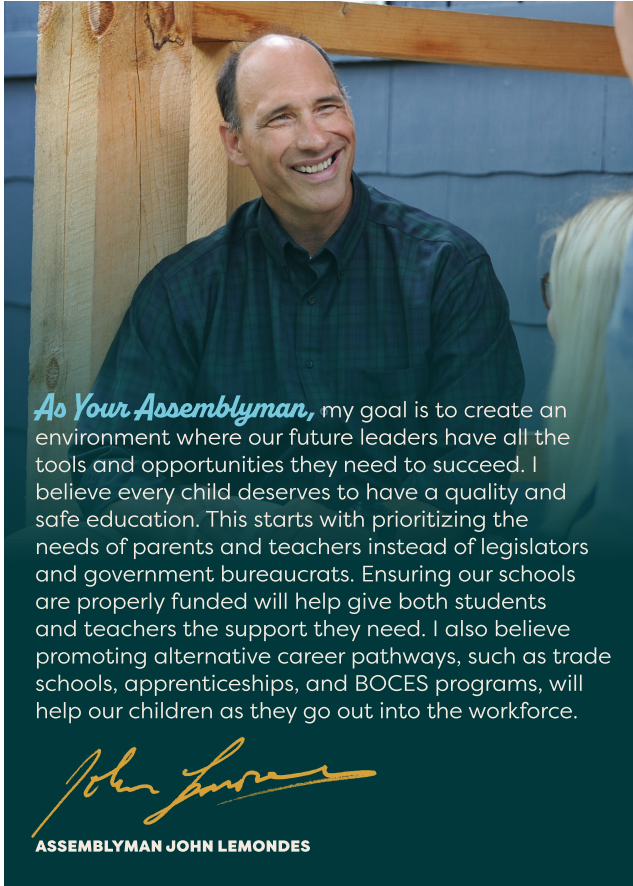

- ✔ **\$47.6 million** increase in BOCES and Special Services Aid programs (A.3003-D)
- ✔ **\$169 million** for expanded free school meals (A.3003-D)
- ✔ **\$111.9 million** for Blind and Deaf schools (A.3003-D)
- ✔ **\$99.6 million** for Library Aid (A.3003-D)

Highlighting local funding:

- ✔ **\$54 million** increase in total School Aid (A.3003-D)
- ✔ An over **14% increase** in funding for Auburn City School District (A.3003-D)
