Applying for financial aid can be a challenge. That's why we're here to help. If you'd like to complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form at the Financial Aid Workshop, be sure to bring:

- ✓ Student's Social Security number bring the card to ensure number is correct
- ✓ Parents' Social Security numbers bring the cards to ensure numbers are correct
- ✓ Parents' dates of birth
- ✓ Student's driver's license number, if student has one
- ✓ **Student's Permanent Alien Registration Number**, if not a U.S. citizen
- ✓ Copy of student's 2013 Federal Income Tax Return
 - If not yet filed, last pay stubs for each job held during 2013 and copy of student's 2012 Federal Income Tax Return
- ✓ Copy of parents' 2013 Federal Income Tax Return
 - If not yet filed, each parent's last pay stub for each job in 2013 and copy of parents' 2012 Federal Income Tax Return
- ✓ Records of student's untaxed income for the following sources of income:
 - Child support payments received in the student's name
 - Interest income
 - Veterans non-education benefits
 - Social Security benefits in the student's name
- ✓ Records of parents' untaxed income for the following sources of income:
 - Child support payments received for all children
 - Interest income
 - Veterans non-education benefits
 - Untaxed portion of pension benefits
 - Untaxed portion of IRA distributions
 - Workers' compensation benefits
 - Disability benefits
