

Protecting Our Planet's Future

Assemblyman Magnarelli passed the New York State Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (Ch. 106 of 2019), which:

- ✓ **Sets goals to combat climate change**, including:
 - reducing greenhouse gas emissions 85% by 2050
 - producing 70% of the state's electricity from renewable energy systems by 2030
 - producing 100% of the state's electricity without emissions by 2040
- ✓ **Establishes the New York State Climate Action Council** to keep the state on track with its goals
- ✓ **15% of New York's energy reduction goal** can come from projects that rehabilitate the environment, including restoring wetlands, reforestation, or other green projects
- ✓ **The act requires the Climate Action Council** to create a scoping plan, which will set out recommendations for reducing emissions across all sectors of the economy, including the transportation, building, industrial, commercial, and agricultural sectors
