This legislative session, Brian has supported legislation which:

Implements a shoreline hardening plan for people who own property along Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River in order to prevent further damage from flooding (A.8561)

Establishes the safe water and infrastructure action program for the purpose of making payments toward the replacement and rehabilitation of existing local, municipally-owned and funded drinking water, storm water, and sanitary sewer systems (A.0424)

Designates Sauquoit Creek as an inland waterway for purposes of waterfront revitalization (A.4364-A)

Adds a new section to the Environmental Conservation Law to control the growth of invasive aquatic plants (A.4570)
