## Brian has sponsored legislation which would:

- Establish the Veterans' Memorials Preservation Act (A.7884)
- Provide free use of state parks to families of deceased military (A.4993)
- Ensure the veterans remembrance and cemetery maintenance and operation fund is sufficiently funded (A.0887)

## He has also supported legislation to:

- Provide information on where to seek help in regard to military sexual trauma (A.2459-A)
- Enact the Pension Poaching Prevention Act (A.6292)
- Sestablish a tax exemption for improvements to the property owned by severely injured members of the military (A.7289)
- Update the duties of the women veterans coordinator within the New York State Division of Veterans Services (A.7594)
- Require local veterans' service agencies to help veterans with the process of submitting applications for a discharge upgrade (A.8096)
