- "Gabby's Law," which would establish a coordinated law enforcement adult rescue "teal alert" for missing adults in domestic violence cases (A3230)
- Establish the crime of assault on a pregnant woman (A3604)
- "The Domestic Violence Protection Act -Helen's Law" would make it mandatory for violent felons to register. It outlines responsibilities for the Division of Criminal Justice Services, including setting up a special phone line and keeping a list of violent offenders (A3665)
