#### Why Is Home Fire Preparedness so Important?

Every day, seven people die in home fires, most often in homes without working smoke alarms. That's why the American Red Cross launched its *Home Fire Campaign* in 2014 to save lives.




## Organ Donation by the Numbers

(as of October 2022)

One donor can save the lives of 8 people through organ donation and improve the lives of 75 more through eye and tissue donations.

- Number of New Yorkers on organ donation waiting list: Nearly 8,300.
- Number of New Yorkers who have been on the waiting list for 5 or more years: Nearly 1,250.
- Number of New Yorkers who died waiting for a transplant in 2021: Approximately 475.
- Registry Participation Rate: 44% of eligible population, ranking 50th out of 52 states and territories.
- New York State has the 3rd highest need for donors but the 3rd lowest donor enrollment rate in the U.S.
