Organ Donation by the Numbers


(as of July 2024)

One donor can save the lives of 8 people through organ donation and improve the lives of 75 more through eye and tissue donations.

- Number of New Yorkers on organ donation waiting list: nearly 8,000.
- Number of New Yorkers who have been on the waiting list for 5 or more years: 1,000.
- Number of New Yorkers who died waiting for a transplant in 2023: nearly 400.
- Registry Participation Rate: 49% of the eligible population in New York, compared to the national average of 64%.
- New York State has the 3rd highest need for donors but the 3rd lowest donor enrollment rate in the U.S.
