As Ranking Member of the Assembly's Health Committee, Josh has sponsored legislation to: increase our nurse career pipeline (A.3372), increase capacity to provide critically important care (A.3290), and bring our frontline healthcare workers back into care (A.2989).



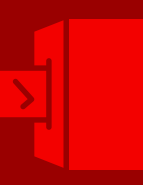

Josh is working to protect taxpayer dollars by introducing legislation:



- a. **"Respect Taxpayer Dollars Act," a bill to require fiscal transparency on state spending, and mandated audits of executive orders and uses of federal funds (A.2903).**
- b. **Implementing a state spending cap, to limit the growth of record setting spending of taxpayer dollars by New York state (A.5893).**

Josh sought to stop Albany overreach from nationalizing local elections and interfering in local community decision making by proposing a hostile amendment to the legislation (A.4282) that would force municipal elections to move to even-numbered years. He proposed allowing local communities and governments to make that decision themselves rather than having the state force it to occur.
