This workshop offers an overview of key legal documents and decisions that support healthy aging, including powers of attorney, health care proxies, MOLST forms, wills, and trusts. Attendees will learn the purpose of each document, how they work together, and important considerations for protecting their health, finances, and future plans.

- **10:30 am – 12:30 pm: Medicaid Planning for Long-Term Care**, presented by Jeremy Sedelmeyer, JD
Understanding how to prepare for the potential costs of long-term care is an important part of aging well. Attendees will learn about common misconceptions, key application considerations, and how proactive planning can help preserve financial resources while accessing needed care.
