On Monday, April 8, between 2:07 p.m. and 4:33 p.m., the Greater Rochester region will find itself in the path of totality for the solar eclipse. The total eclipse will occur at 3:20 p.m. and last for 3 minutes and 38 seconds in Rochester.

Rochester is one of only a few communities in New York that will be in the path of totality on April 8.
