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ASSEMBLYMEMBER BRONSON: INVESTING IN EDUCATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR STRONG FUTURES

The 2026-27 State budget Assemblymember Bronson helped to pass includes:

- \$62 million in new funding for schools across the 138th District, including a 2% increase in Foundation Aid *(FY'27 Budget)*
- \$116 million for after-school programs, state-wide. *(FY'27 Budget)*
- Extends the zero-emission bus mandates by five years, allowing districts more time to implement this new transportation *(FY'27 Budget)*
- \$20 million to fund a Universal Child Care Pilot in Monroe County and increase access to affordable child care *(FY'27 Budget)*
- Free breakfast and lunch at all k12 public schools *(FY' 26 Budget)*
- Supporting NY's Public Libraries with increased Library Aid and \$10 million additional funding for Library Construction Aid *(FY'27 Budget)*
- Additional funding for BOCES to jumpstart career access for high school students and providing funding for the successful ROC Your Job Program to connect Rochester and Monroe County high school students with afterschool and summer jobs *(FY'27 Budget)*
- Increased the Excelsior Scholarship eligibility and TAP eligibility by raising the income thresholds *(FY'27 Budget)*
- Expanded the Opportunity Promise Scholarship for free Associate Degrees at community colleges for high-demand fields *(FY'27 Budget)*
