is fighting for funding to keep us safe

- More than **\$250,000** to the Town of Tonawanda Police Department to purchase **new squad car equipment**, along with \$37,000 for **crime prevention, education and community engagement programs**
- **\$125,000** to the North Tonawanda Police Department for **upgrades to its SWAT truck, mobile radar units and training equipment**
- **\$125,000** to the City of Tonawanda Police Department to help replace **portable communications equipment, fund three new stations at the city's 911 dispatch center** and purchase a **new police vehicle**
- **\$73,000** to the Tonawanda City School District to help fund a **full-time school resource officer**
- **\$20,000** for the Village of Kenmore Police Department for **body cameras and other essential equipment**
