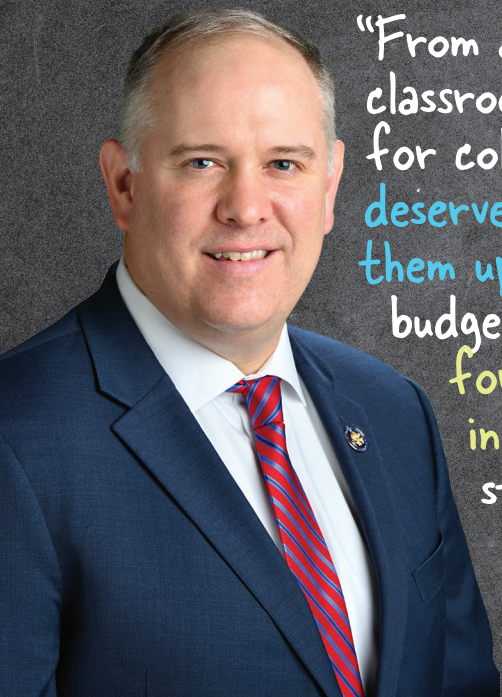

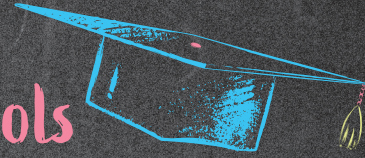

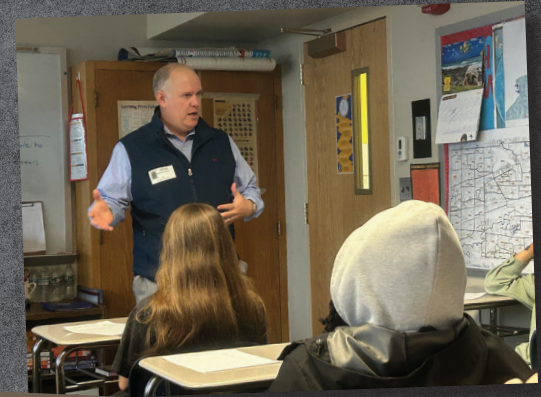

Assemblyman Bill Conrad: Helping provide for Kenmore-Town of Tonawanda schools



- ✓ An increase of over **\$1 million** in Foundation Aid from last year for a total of nearly **\$54 million**
- ✓ **\$1.5 million** in funding for the TeachNY program, supporting his efforts to address teacher recruitment and build diversity in the field (A.3668)
- ✓ Fought for and secured **\$21.4 million** to fully fund the Teacher Resource and Computer Training Centers to support statewide professional development programs
- ✓ An increase of over **\$1.4 million** in Universal Pre-Kindergarten (UPK) funding over last year, and expands UPK to full-day instruction for 4-year-olds by Fall 2028
- ✓ Expands the **New York Opportunity Promise Scholarship Program** that helps New Yorkers ages 25-55 earn an associate degree in high demand fields
- ✓ Secured funding for **universal free school meals**
- ✓ Expands the **NYS Masters-in-Education Teacher Incentive Scholarship Program** to support students seeking careers as early childhood educators
- ✓ **\$12 million** for SUNY campuses
- ✓ An additional **\$1.7 million** in library aid for a total of over **\$106.4 million** statewide

All funding is included in the 2026-27 NYS Budget
