# WHY YOU SHOULD CARE

- Economic Impact This project would create 1,000 construction jobs with an opportunity for inclusion and job training. It would increase property values and allow families to build generational wealth.
- Environmental Remediation Planting more trees will help improve air quality and help prevent health ailments. Increased green space will increase recreational activity.
- Improved Quality of Life and Restorative Justice Buffalo's East Side is finally starting to participate in Buffalo's historic economic renaissance. Positive activity leads to a reduction in crime. This project compliments the \$50 million being invested by New York State into East Side Commercial Corridors (Jefferson, Fillmore, Michigan and Bailey Avenues).

#### **REPAIRING DAMAGE...**

- Construction of the Route 33 Kensington Expressway decimated residential property values.
- Community health has been negatively impacted by way of increased upper respiratory illnesses and cancer rates most likely caused by vehicle emissions and pollution.
- Thriving commercial corridors (Jefferson and Fillmore Avenues) and respective businesses succumbed as their regular traffic and customers were rerouted onto the Route 33 Kensington Expressway, completely bypassing them.

## **OPPORTUNITIES...THE TIME IS NOW**

- NYSDOT's 5-year Capital Plan will be renewed as of April 1, 2020. This project should be included.
- This project made Congress for the New Urbanism's 2019 list of Freeways without Futures.
- Deteriorating infrastructure the retaining walls are at the end
  of their lifespans; guardrails were replaced, but not before fatal
  tragedy struck, as 3 accidents saw cars plunge onto the expressway;
  today's design regulations call for increased shoulder width for
  emergencies.







## **HUMBOLDT PARKWAY'S HISTORY**

- Designed by Frederick Law Olmsted in 1868 as part of the United States' 1st urban parks system.
- A combined 850 acres of historic parkland maintained within the City of Buffalo by the Buffalo Olmsted Parks Conservancy.
- Olmsted Parks Conservancy recently celebrated its 150th anniversary.
- The Rt. 33 Kensington Expressway's 10 miles of construction took NYSDOT longer to build than the entire NYS Thruway's 427 miles (16 years (1954-1970) vs 10 years (1946-1956)).
