Progress report on creating jobs, cutting taxes and growing the economy

- Supported crucial middle-class tax cuts, particularly for households earning between \$40,000 and \$150,000
- Enhanced the Child and Dependent Care Credit for working families earning between \$50,000 and \$150,000
- Provided \$2.5 billion for clean water infrastructure projects to protect our drinking water and \$643 million to improve roads and bridges and create new local jobs
