# Assemblymember Wallace is working to ensure equal opportunity for all

This year, Assemblymember Wallace expanded and strengthened support for those with disabilities by:

- ✓ Securing \$10,000 to bring ADA-compliant playground equipment to Cheektowaga
- ✓ Securing \$15,000 to make local libraries more accessible for everyone
- ✓ Partnering with nonprofit volunteer organizations like Fantastic Friends to provide welcoming spaces for people living with developmental disabilities



- ✓ Supporting the bFair2DirectCare campaign to give much-needed raises to direct care workers
- ✓ Fighting for a small business tax credit for the employment of people with disabilities (A.7475)

Assemblymember Wallace is currently urging the NYS Department of Transportation (DOT) to add “Child with Autism” signs to the state’s list of allowable road signage to help keep children with autism safe in our neighborhoods.
