Assemblymember Monica Wallace secures grant for Cheektowaga Boys and Girls Club

Assemblymember Wallace helped secure \$100,000 in this year's state budget to help with the initial startup costs of opening a Boys & Girls Club in Cheektowaga. She also secured a \$250,000 grant for Cheektowaga to make security and accessibility updates to the Alexander Community Center building for the club's location.



Assemblymember Wallace invited Speaker Carl E. Heastie and Majority Leader Crystal Peoples-Stokes to tour the site of the future Boys & Girls Club.

Increasing access to affordable child care

- Supported the creation of the New York State Employer-Provided Child Care Credit to encourage employers to provide child and dependent care facilities for their employees
