SERVING THOSE WHO KEEP US SAFE:

- Aggressively prosecute cases of resisting arrest by creating a felony crime for repeat offenders. (A.5707)
- Fighting to protect our law enforcement officers from abuse while they're working to keep our community safe (A.8528).
- Increasing the earning cap for police officers who retire under the age of 65 (A.2858-B).
- Designating certain offenses against emergency medical services personnel, firefighters, and law enforcement officers as hate crimes (A.6169).

- Establishing a school resource officer program allowing school districts and non-public schools to hire retired law enforcement officers (A.3732).
- Creating a police safety equipment grant program to provide for services and expenses required to keep our officers safe while performing their duties (A.6387).
- Amend the crime of aggravated assault upon a police officer by removing the requirement that the offender must use a deadly weapon or dangerous instrument when intentionally causing serious physical injury to a police officer or peace officer. (A.6402)
