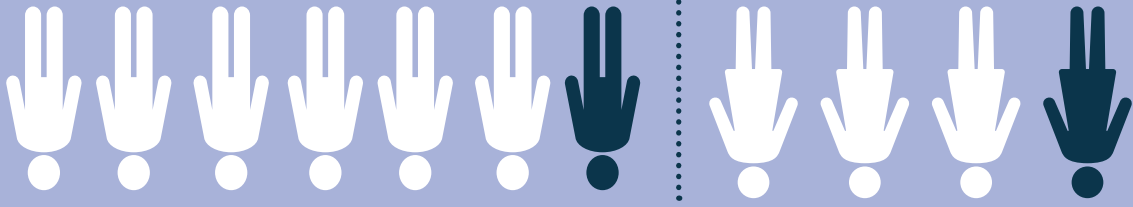

Named after Gabby Peto, the 22-year-old New Yorker whose tragic disappearance and eventual murder by her boyfriend captured the nation in 2022, "Gabby's Law" would streamline reporting of these types of cases and increase awareness and the chance of recovery of missing persons and allow New York State to join an existing national alert program for missing persons (A.3230).
