Cottentail Rabbit	October 1 - February 28	6/day
Ruffed Grouse	October 1 - February 28	4/day
Pheasant	October 19 - February 28	2/day
Varying Hare	January 1 - January 31	6/day
Turkey	October 19 - November 15	1/season
Whitetail Deer	Early Archery – October 1 - November 15 Regular Season – November 16 - December 8 Muzzleloader – December 9 - December 17 Late Archery – December 9 - December 17	
Bear	Early Archery – October 1 - November 15 Late Archery – December 9 - December 17 Regular Season – November 16 - December 8 Muzzleloader – December 9 - December 17	
Coyote	October 1 - March 30

Note: During the youth deer hunt, mentors may not carry a firearm, crossbow, or bow to pursue deer.
