DAVID'S PLAN TO FIX THE CRISIS:

- 💡 Protect municipalities from "Right to Shelter" confusion by requiring local governing bodies in the state to opt-in to accepting migrants from other jurisdictions (A.8034).
- 💡 Ensure funding is not used to shelter migrants in schools, daycare centers or community organization buildings (A.8013).
- 💡 End New York's status as an undocumented migrant sanctuary until proper planning is discussed.
- 💡 Background checks for all migrants entering New York State (A.7319). Advocate for comprehensive Health and Mental Health checks.
