Child Care is Essential





- Provide a supplemental 15% Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit equal to roughly \$345 per family.¹
- Create more child care seats for providers by doubling the Child Care Creation & Expansion Tax Credit amount from \$25 million per year to \$50 million per year.²
- Create a new Child Care Facility Capital Improvement Tax Credit to encourage more provider options and facility improvements for providers.³

EXPANDING ACCESS TO EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION

- Allow local governments to offer property tax exemptions on licensed child day care centers.⁴
- Ensure child care agencies are adequately staffed by following regulations regarding staffing ratios and class sizes.⁵
- Streamline the hiring process for qualified pre-k teachers and minimize the costs for new and existing programs.⁵

INCREASING ACCESSIBILITY AND TACKLING AFFORDABILITY

- Increase provider options by establishing child care models for nights and weekends.⁶
- Allow child care to be provided in-home as an alternative day care setting expanding parental choice.⁷
- Average Family Total Savings = \$2,336.8
